- Support patients who wish to quit smoking through our Smoking Cessation Program in association with CAMH and the Ottawa Model for Smoking Cessation
- Will lead or collaborate with other health care providers for provision of group classes and specialized program delivery
- Knowledge and experience working collaboratively with community resources
- Applies recognized clinical practice guidelines and best practices to screening, monitoring, and assessment of patient's physical and emotional well-being
- Provides care and management for patients with a wide range of health issues
